1. _____ Daring, self-willed, they do not tremble when they revile angelic majesties, whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord. But these, like **unreasoning animals**, born as creatures of instinct to be captured and killed, **reviling where they have no knowledge**, will in the destruction of those creatures also be destroyed, suffering wrong as the wages of doing wrong. They count it a pleasure to revel in the daytime. They are **stains and blemishes**, reveling in their deceptions, as they carouse with you, having **eyes full of adultery that never cease from sin**, enticing unstable souls, having a heart trained in **greed**, accursed children; forsaking the right way, they have gone astray, having followed the way of _____, the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; but he received a rebuke for his own transgression, for a mute donkey, speaking with a voice of a man, restrained the madness of the prophet.

2. _____ Now therefore, the sword shall never depart from your house, because **you have despised Me** and have taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your wife.' Thus says the Lord, 'Behold, I will raise up evil against you from your own household; I will even take your wives before your eyes and give them to your companion, and he will lie with your wives in broad daylight. Indeed you did it secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel, and under the sun.'" Then _____ said to Nathan, "I have sinned against the Lord." And Nathan said to _____, "The Lord also has taken away your sin; you shall not die. However, because by **this deed you have given occasion to the enemies of the Lord to blaspheme**, the child also that is born to you shall surely die." So Nathan went to his house.

3. _____ 'I know where you dwell, **where Satan's throne is**; and you hold fast My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days of Antipas, My witness, My faithful one, who was killed among you, **where Satan dwells**. But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the teaching of _____, who kept teaching Balak to put a **stumbling block before the sons of Israel**, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit

acts of immorality. So you also have some who in the same way hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans. **Therefore repent;** or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with **the sword of My mouth.**

4. _____ In those days I also saw that the **Jews had married women from Ashdod, Ammon and Moab.** As for their children, half spoke in the language of Ashdod, and **none of them was able to speak the language of Judah,** but the language of his own people. So I contended with them and cursed them and struck some of them and pulled out their hair, and made them swear by God, "You shall not give your daughters to their sons, nor take of their daughters for your sons or for yourselves. Did not _____ king of Israel sin regarding these things? Yet among the many nations there was no king like him, and **he was loved by his God, and God made him king over all Israel;** nevertheless **the foreign women caused even him to sin.** Do we then hear about you that you have committed all this great evil by **acting unfaithfully against our God by marrying foreign women?"**

5. _____ So _____ saw that the daughters of Canaan displeased his father Isaac; and _____ went to Ishmael, and married, **besides the wives that he had,** Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael, Abraham's son, the sister of Nebaioth.

6.A. _____ While Israel remained at Shittim, **the people began to play the harlot with the daughters of Moab.** For they invited the people to the **sacrifices of their gods,** and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. So **Israel joined themselves to Baal of Peor,** and **the Lord was angry against Israel.** The Lord said to Moses, "Take all the leaders of the people and execute them in broad daylight before the Lord, so that the fierce anger of the Lord may turn away from Israel." So Moses said to the judges of Israel, "**Each of you slay his men who have joined themselves to Baal of Peor.**"

6.B. And Moses said to them, "Have you spared all the women? Behold, **these caused the sons of Israel,** through the counsel of _____, to **trespass against the Lord** in the matter of **Peor,** so the plague was among the congregation of the Lord.

7.A. _____ So he came back and told his father and mother, "I saw a woman in Timnah, one of the **daughters of the Philistines;** now therefore, get her for me as a wife." Then his father and his mother said to him, "Is there no woman among the daughters of your relatives, or among all our people, that **you go to take a wife from the uncircumcised Philistines?"** But _____ said to his father, "Get her for me, for **she looks good to me.**"

7.B. Then she said to him, "**How can you say, 'I love you,'** when your heart is not with me? You have deceived me these three times and have not told me where your great strength is." It came about when **she pressed him daily with her words and urged him,** that **his soul was annoyed to death.**

8. _____ Now King _____ loved many foreign women along with the daughter of Pharaoh: Moabite, Ammonite, Edomite, Sidonian, and Hittite women, from the nations concerning which the Lord had said to the sons of Israel, "You shall not associate with them, nor shall they associate with you, for **they will surely turn your heart away after their gods.**" _____ held fast to these in love. He had **seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines, and his wives turned his heart away.**

9. _____ There is no one greater in this house than I, and he has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. **How then could I do this great evil and sin against God?**" As she spoke to _____ day after day, he did not listen to her to lie beside her or be with her. Now it happened one day that he went into the house to do his work, and none of the men of the household was there inside. She caught him by his garment, saying, "Lie with me!" And **he left his garment in her hand and fled, and went outside.**

10. _____ Then God said to him in the dream, "Yes, I know that in the integrity of your heart you have done this, and **I also kept you from sinning against Me**; therefore I did not let you touch her. Now therefore, **restore the man's wife**, for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you and you will live. But if you do not restore her, know that you shall surely die, you and all who are yours."
