9 For you recall, brethren, our (_____) and (_____), how **working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you**, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

10 You are witnesses, and so is God, how (_____) and (_____) and (_____) we behaved toward you believers;

11 just as you know how we were (_____) and encouraging and (_____) each one of you as a father would his own children,

12 so that you would (_____) **in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.**

1 Thessalonians 4:9-12

9 Now as to the **love of the brethren**, you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to (_____) one another;

10 for indeed you do practice it toward all the brethren who are in all Macedonia. But we urge you, brethren, **to excel still more**,

11 and to make it your ambition to lead a (_____) life and attend to your own (_____) and work with your (_____), just as we commanded you,

12 so that you will **behave properly** toward outsiders and **not be in any need**.

2 Thessalonians 3:6-13

6 Now we (_____) you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you **keep away from every brother** who leads an (_____) life and not according to the tradition which you received from us.

7 For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our (_____), because we did not act in an undisciplined manner among you,

8 nor did we eat anyone's bread without (_____) for it, but with (_____) and hardship we kept (_____) night and day **so that we would not be a burden to any of you**;

9 not because we do not have the right to this, but in order to offer ourselves as a (_____) for you, so that you would follow our example.

10 For even when we were with you, **we used to give you this order**:

11 For we hear that some among you are leading an (_____) life, doing no work at all, but acting like busybodies.

12 Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ to (_____) **in quiet fashion and eat their own bread**.

13 But as for you, brethren, **do not grow weary of doing** (_____).
