Week 13 Homework: Read Psalm 45, Deuteronomy chapters 1-11, & the book of Zechariah

Key Point: "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up; John 3:14

Romans 1:18-32		
18 For the wrath of God is revealed from () against all ungodliness and	
unrighteousness of men who suppress the (_) in unrighteousness,	
19 because that which is known about Go	is () within them;	
for God made it (
20 For since the creation of the world His invi	sible (), His eternal	
	e (), have been clearly	
seen, being understood through what has	been made, so that they are without excuse.	
21 For even though they knew God, they did	not () Him as God or	
give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.		
22 Professing to be wise, they became fools,		
23 and exchanged the glory of the () God for an image	
in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.		
24 Therefore God () them over in the lusts of their hearts to	
impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.		
25 For they exchanged the () of God for a lie, and worshiped	
and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.		
26 For this reason God () them over to degrading passions ; for	
their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural,		
27 and in the same way also the men abandoned the natural function of the woman and		
burned in their desire toward one another, r	nen with men committing ()	
acts and receiving in their own persons the d	ue penalty of their ().	
28 And just as they did not see fit to acknow l	edge God any longer, God () them	
over to a () mir	nd, to do those things which are not proper,

10 and especially those who indulge the flesh in its corrupt desires and despise authority.		
Daring, self-willed, they do not () when they revile angelic majesties,	
11 whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling		
() against them bef		
12 But these, like unreasoning (), born as creatures	
of instinct to be captured and killed, $\ensuremath{\textbf{reviling where}}$	they have no knowledge, will in the	
destruction of those creatures also be destroyed,		
13 () wrong as the wa	ges of ()	
wrong. They count it a pleasure to revel in the daytime. They are stains and blemishes ,

reveling in their (

14 having eyes full of adultery that never of	ease from sin, ()	
unstable souls, having a heart trained in gr	reed, accursed children;	
15 forsaking the right way, they have gone	astray, having followed the way of Balaam, the	
son of Beor, who loved the wages of unr	ghteousness;	
16 but he received a rebuke for his own trans	sgression, for a mute (),	
speaking with a voice of a man, restrained	the madness of the ().	
17 These are springs without water and mis	ts driven by a storm, for whom the black	
darkness has been reserved.		
18 For speaking out () words of vanity they entice by fleshly	
desires, by (), those	who barely escape from the ones who live in error,	
19 promising them () while they themselves are slaves of	
corruption; for by what a man is (), by this he is enslaved.	
20 For if, after they have () the defilements of the world by	
the () of th	e Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again	
entangled in them and are overcome, the la	st state has become worse for them than the first.	
21 For it would be better for them not to have	e known the way of righteousness , than having	
known it, to turn away from the holy comm	nandment handed on to them.	
22 It has happened to them according to the	e true proverb, "A () returns to	
its own vomit," and, "A (), after washing, returns to wallowing in the mire."		
Revelation 2:13-14		
13 'I know where you dwell, where () throne is ; and you hold	
fast My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days of Antipas, My witness, My faithful		
one, who was killed among you, where () dwells.	
14 But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the		
teaching of (), w	ho kept teaching Balak to put a stumbling block	
before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit acts of immorality.
