Week 13 Homework: Read **Psalm 45**, **Deuteronomy** chapters 1-11, & the book of **Zechariah**

Key Point: “And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness,
even so must the **Son of Man** be lifted up; John 3:14

Romans 1:18-32

18 For the **wrath of God** is revealed from (_____) against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the (_____) in unrighteousness,
19 because **that which is known about God** is (_____) within them; for God made it (_____) to them.

20 For since the creation of the world His invisible (_____), His eternal (_____) and divine (_____), have been clearly seen, **being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.**

21 For even though they knew God, they did not (_____) Him as God or **give thanks**, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

22 Professing to be wise, they became fools,

23 and exchanged the glory of the (_____) God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.

24 **Therefore** God (_____) them over in the **lusts of their hearts** to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.

25 For they exchanged the (_____) of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

26 **For this reason** God (_____) them over to **degrading passions**; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural,

27 and in the same way also the men abandoned the **natural function** of the woman and **burned in their desire** toward one another, men with men committing (_____) acts and receiving in their own persons the **due penalty** of their (_____).

28 And just as they did not see fit to **acknowledge God** any longer, God (_____) them over to a (_____) mind, **to do those things which are not proper,**

29 being filled with **all unrighteousness**, wickedness, **greed**, evil; **full of envy**, murder, **strife**, deceit, **malice**; they are **gossips**, 30 slanderers, **haters of God**, insolent, **arrogant**, boastful, inventors of evil, **disobedient to parents**,

31 without understanding, **untrustworthy**, unloving, **unmerciful**;

32 and **although they know** the ordinance of God, that those who **practice** such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty (_____) to those who **practice** them.

John 3:13-18

13 **No one** has ascended into (_____), but He who descended from (_____): **the Son of Man**.

14 As Moses lifted up the **serpent** in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up; 15 **so that whoever believes will in** (_____) **have eternal life**.

16 "For God so loved the world, that He (_____) His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in (_____) shall not perish, but have eternal life.

17 For God did not send the Son into the world to (_____) the world, **but that the world might be saved** through (_____).

18 **He who believes in Him is not judged**; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the (_____) of the only begotten Son of God.

Numbers 21:4-8

4 Then they set out from Mount Hor by the way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the people became (_____) because of the journey.

5 The people spoke (_____) God and Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no (_____) and no (_____), and we loathe this miserable food."

6 The (_____) sent **fiery serpents** among the people and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel (_____).

7 So the people came to Moses and said, "**We have sinned**, because we have spoken against the Lord and you; (_____) with the Lord, that He may remove the serpents from us." And Moses (_____) for the people.

8 Then the Lord said to Moses, "**Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a standard**; and it shall come about, that everyone who is (_____), **when he looks at it, he will live.**"

2 Peter 2:4-22

4 For if **God did not spare angels when they** (_____), but cast them into hell and committed them to **pits of darkness**, reserved for (_____);

5 and **did not spare the ancient world**, but preserved Noah, a (_____) of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the **ungodly**;

6 and if He (_____) the cities of **Sodom and Gomorrah** to destruction by reducing them to ashes, having made them an (_____) to those who would live **ungodly lives** thereafter;

7 and if He rescued (_____) Lot, **oppressed by the sensual conduct of unprincipled men**

8 (for by what he saw and heard that (_____) man, while living among them, **felt his righteous soul tormented day after day** by their lawless deeds),

9 then **the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation**, and to keep the unrighteous under (_____) for the day of (_____),

10 and **especially those who indulge the flesh** in its corrupt desires and **despise authority**. Daring, self-willed, they do not (_____) when they revile angelic majesties,

11 whereas **angels who are greater in might and power** do not bring a reviling (_____) against them before the Lord.

12 But these, **like unreasoning** (_____), born as creatures of instinct to be captured and killed, **reviling where they have no knowledge**, will in the destruction of those creatures also be destroyed,

13 (_____) wrong as the wages of (_____) wrong. They count it a pleasure to revel in the daytime. They are **stains and blemishes**, reveling in their (_____), as they carouse with you,

14 having **eyes full of adultery** that never cease from sin, (_____)
unstable souls, having a **heart trained in greed**, accursed children;

15 forsaking the right way, **they have gone astray, having followed the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;**

16 but he received a rebuke for his own transgression, for a mute (_____),
speaking with a voice of a man, **restrained the madness of the** (_____).

17 These are springs without water and mists driven by a storm, for whom **the black darkness has been reserved.**

18 For speaking out (_____) **words of vanity** they entice **by fleshly desires, by** (_____), those who barely escape from the ones who live in error,

19 **promising them** (_____) while they themselves are **slaves** of corruption; **for by what a man is** (_____), **by this he is enslaved.**

20 **For if, after** they have (_____) the defilements of the world by the (_____) **of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ**, they are again entangled in them and are overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first.

21 For it would be better for them not to have known the **way of righteousness**, than having known it, **to turn away from the holy commandment handed on to them.**

22 It has happened to them according to the true proverb, "A (_____) returns to its own vomit," and, "A (_____), after washing, returns to wallowing in the mire."

Revelation 2:13-14

13 'I know where you dwell, **where** (_____) **throne is**; and you hold fast **My name**, and did not deny **My faith** even in the days of Antipas, **My witness, My faithful one**, who was killed among you, **where** (_____) **dwells.**

14 But I have a few things against you, because **you have there some who hold the teaching of** (_____), who kept teaching Balak to put a **stumbling block** before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to **idols** and to **commit acts of immorality.**
