### **Week 14 – Deuteronomy Overview**

**Week 14 Homework:** Read **Psalm 81**, **Deuteronomy** chapters 12-25, & the book of **Joshua**

**Key Point: Teach your kids** – 70% of children of offenders serve time in jail = 93 out of 133

#### **Deuteronomy 8:1-11**

1 "All the commandments that I am commanding you today you shall be careful to (\_\_\_\_\_), that you may (\_\_\_\_\_) and multiply, and go in and (\_\_\_\_\_) the land which the Lord swore to give to your forefathers.

2 **You shall remember** all the way which the Lord your God has led you in the wilderness these forty years, that He might (\_\_\_\_\_) you, (\_\_\_\_\_) you, to know what was in your **heart**, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

3 **He humbled you** and let you be (\_\_\_\_\_), **and fed you** with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that **He might make you understand** that man does not live by (\_\_\_\_\_) alone, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord.

4 Your clothing did not wear out on you, nor did your foot swell these forty years.

5 Thus you are to know in your (\_\_\_\_\_) that the Lord your God was (\_\_\_\_\_) you **just as a man disciplines his son**.

6 Therefore, you shall (\_\_\_\_\_) the commandments of the Lord your God, to (\_\_\_\_\_) in His ways and to (\_\_\_\_\_) Him.

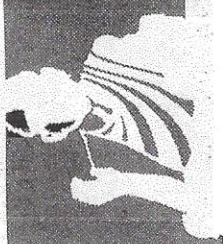
7 For the Lord your God is bringing you into a **good land**, a land of brooks of **water**, of **fountains and springs**, flowing forth in valleys and hills;

8 a land of **wheat and barley**, of **vines and fig trees** and **pomegranates**, a land of **olive oil** and **honey**;

9 a land where you will **eat food without scarcity**, in which you will not **lack anything**; a land whose stones are (\_\_\_\_\_), and out of whose hills you can dig (\_\_\_\_\_).

10 **When you have eaten and are satisfied**, you shall (\_\_\_\_\_) the Lord your God for the good land **which He has given you**.

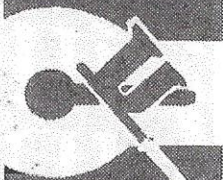

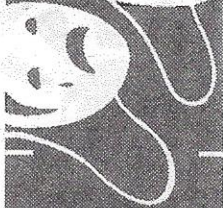

### **Deuteronomy 8:11**

### **Joel 1:1-3**

1 The word of the Lord that came to Joel, the son of Pethuel:

2 **Hear** this, O elders, **And listen**, all inhabitants of the land. Has anything like this happened in your days Or in your fathers' days?

### **1 Samuel 12:18-25**

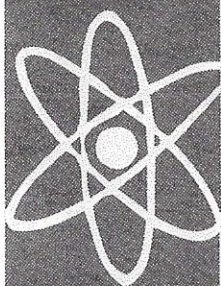
25 But if you still do wickedly, both you and your king will be swept away."

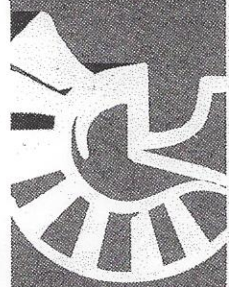
**460** Birth of Democritus, who introduced an atomic theory by arguing that all bodies are made of indivisible and unchangeable atoms
