**Week 15 Homework:** Read **Psalm 68**, **Deuteronomy** chapters 26-34, & **Daniel** chapters 1-6

**Key Point:** History is the starting point for understanding. **God starts the bible with history.**

#### **2 Thessalonians 3:1-10**

1 Finally, brethren, ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) for us that the ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) of the Lord will spread rapidly **and be glorified**, just as it did also with you;

7 For **you yourselves know** how you ought to follow our ( \_\_\_\_\_ ), because **we did not act in an undisciplined manner** among you,

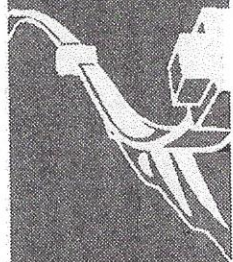

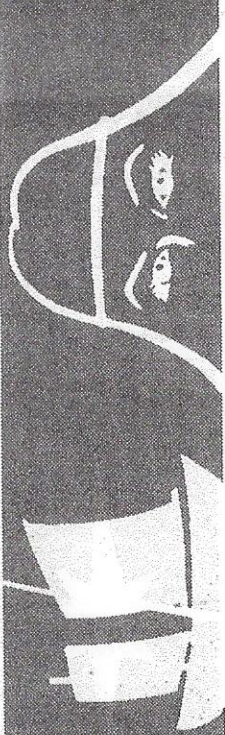

### **Numbers 16:41-49**

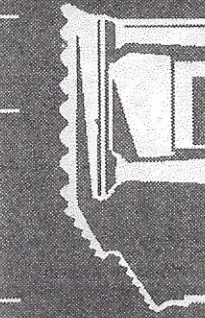
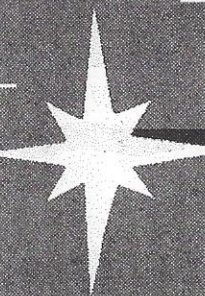
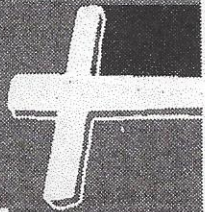
