**Week 16 Homework:** Read Psalm 69, 1 Samuel chapters 1-10, & Daniel chapters 7-12

**Key Point:** Jesus is the captain of the host of the Lord who spoke with Joshua.

Joshua 5:13-15

#### Psalm 69

1 ( ) me, O God, For **the waters have threatened my life.**

2 I have ( ) in deep mire, and there is no ( );

**I have come into deep waters**, and a flood overflows me.

3 I am ( ) with my crying; my throat is parched; My eyes fail while I ( ) for my God.

4 Those who ( ) me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head; Those who would ( ) me are powerful, being wrongfully my enemies; What I did not steal, **I then have to restore.**

5 O God, it is You who knows my folly, **And my wrongs are not hidden from You.**

6 May those who ( ) for You not be ashamed **through me**, O Lord God of hosts; May those who ( ) You not be dishonored **through me**, O God of Israel,

7 **Because for Your sake I have borne reproach**; Dishonor has covered my face.

8 I have become **estranged** from my brothers And an **alien** to my mother's sons.

9 For ( ) for **Your house** has ( ) me, And **the reproaches** of those who reproach ( ) **have fallen on me.**

10 When I wept in my soul with ( ), It became my reproach.

11 When I made ( ) my clothing, I became a byword to them.

12 Those who sit in the ( ) talk about me, And I am the song of the **drunkards.**

13 But as for me, my ( ) is to You, O Lord, at an acceptable time; O God, in the greatness of Your lovingkindness, Answer me with Your saving ( ).

14 ( ) me from the mire and **do not let me sink**; May I be ( ) from my foes and **from the deep waters.**

27 Add iniquity to their iniquity, And may they not come into Your ( \_\_\_\_\_ ).

29 But I am afflicted and in pain; May Your ( \_\_\_\_\_ ), O God, set me securely on high.
