43 And in that you saw the iron mixed with common clay, they will combine with one another in the (_____) of men; but they will not (_____) to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery.

1 Samuel 13:11-14

11 But Samuel said, "What have you done?" And () said, "Because I saw that the people were scattering from me, and that you did not come within the appointed days, and that the Philistines were assembling at Michmash,

12 therefore I said, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not asked the favor of the Lord.' So I forced myself and offered the () offering."

13 Samuel said to Saul, "You have acted (); you have not kept the commandment of the Lord your God, which He commanded you, for now the Lord would have established your () over Israel forever.

14 But now your kingdom shall not endure. The Lord has sought out for Himself a man after His own (), and the Lord has appointed him as ruler over His people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you."

2 Chronicles 26:15-19

15 In Jerusalem he made engines of () invented by skillful men to be on the towers and on the corners for the purpose of shooting arrows and great stones. Hence his fame spread afar, for he was marvelously helped until he was strong.

16 But when he became strong, his () was so proud that he acted corruptly, and he was () to the Lord his God, for he entered the temple of the Lord to burn incense on the altar of incense.

17 Then Azariah the priest entered after him and with him () priests of the Lord, () men.

18 They opposed Uzziah the king and said to him, "It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the Lord, but for the (), the sons of Aaron who are consecrated to burn incense. Get out of the sanctuary, for you have been () and will have no () from the Lord God."

19 But Uzziah, with a censer in his hand for burning incense, was (); and while he was () with the priests, the leprosy broke out on his forehead before the priests in the house of the Lord, beside the altar of incense.
