1. Did you notice the multiple descriptions of twos in Genesis?
God provided two people with a choice between two trees leading to two paths in life. These two people created two sons who presented two different offerings to the Lord. Two family lines were created in Genesis 4:17 & 4:25 that defined two different paths.
2. Compare Genesis 5:22-24, John 3:13, Hebrews 11:5 and 1Corinthians 15:50-58.
We see in 2 Kings 2:11 where Elijah went up by a whirlwind to heaven. Jesus said in John 3:13 no one ascended into heaven except Him. So where did Enoch and Elijah go? See Luke 16:19-31 as a possible answer.
3. Did you notice the food supply change from Genesis 1:29 as compared to Genesis 9:3?
4. What about blood?

Genesis 9:4 "Only **you shall not eat flesh with its life**, that is, its blood.

Leviticus 17:11

For the **life of the flesh is in the blood**, and I have given it to you on the altar to make **atonement** for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.'
