Week 21 Homework: Read Psalm 97, 1 Kings chapters 12-22 & Jeremiah chapters 40-52

Key Point: Jesus made an end of sin and made atonement for iniquity
as foretold in Daniel 9:24

Daniel 9:23-27

23 At the beginning of your supplications the (_____) was issued, and I have come to tell you, for **you are highly esteemed**; so **give** (_____) to the message and **gain** (_____) of the vision.

24 **"Seventy weeks** have been decreed for your people and your holy city, **to finish the** (_____), **to make an end of** (_____), **to make** (_____) **for iniquity, to bring in everlasting** (_____), **to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place.**

25 So **you are to know and** (_____) that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem **until Messiah the Prince there will be seven** (_____) and sixty-two (_____); it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

26 Then **after the sixty-two** (_____) **the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary.** And its end will come with a (_____); even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

27 And **he will make a firm covenant with the many for one** (_____), but in the middle of the (_____) he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come **one who makes desolate**, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on **the one who makes desolate."**
