29 And do not seek what you will eat and what you will drink, and do not keep (_____).

30 For all these things the nations of the world eagerly seek; but your (_____) knows that you need these things.

31 But seek His (_____), and these things will be added to you.

32 Do not be (_____), little flock, for **your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom.**

33 "Sell your possessions and give to (_____); make yourselves money belts which do not wear out, an unfailing (_____) in heaven, where no thief comes near nor moth destroys.

11 But _____) from these things, **you man of God**, and **pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness.**
