### Week 5 – Genesis Overview

**Week 5 Homework:** Read **Psalm 89**, **Isaiah** chapters 40-55 & **Exodus** chapters 1-6

**Key Point:** Twelve tribes were created for God's glory just like the **Kingdom of God** for Jesus.

#### Genesis 32:9-12

9 Jacob said, "O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, O Lord, who said to me, '(\_\_\_\_\_)' to your country and to your relatives, and I (\_\_\_\_\_) prosper you,'  
10 I am unworthy of all the (\_\_\_\_\_) and of all the **faithfulness** which You have shown to Your servant; for with my staff only I crossed this Jordan, and now I have become two companies. 11 Deliver me, I pray, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau; for I fear him, that he will come and attack me and the mothers with the children.

**Genesis 17:17-19**
