**Week 7 Homework:** Read **Psalm 31**, **Exodus** chapters 15-31, & the book of **Hosea**

**Key Point:** ... born not of **blood**, nor of the **will of the flesh**,  
nor of the **will of man**, but of **God**. John 1:13

**Isaiah 53**

**1 Who has believed our message?**

13 You have a strong arm; Your hand is mighty, **Your right hand is exalted.**

14 ( ) and ( ) are the foundation of Your throne; ( ) and **truth go before You.**

15 **How blessed are the people who know the joyful sound!** O Lord, they ( ) in the ( ) of Your countenance.

16 In Your ( ) they rejoice all the day,

**And by Your righteousness they are exalted.**

17 For You are the glory of their strength, And by Your favor our horn is exalted.

18 For our shield belongs to the Lord, And our king to the ( ) of Israel.

19 Once You spoke in ( ) to Your godly ones, And said, "I have given help to one who is mighty; **I have exalted one chosen from the people.**

20 "I have found ( ) My servant;

**With My holy oil I have anointed him,**

22 **"The enemy will not deceive him, Nor the son of ( ) afflict him.**

23 **"But I shall crush his adversaries before him, And strike those who hate him.**

24 "My ( ) and My ( ) will be with him, And in My ( ) his horn will be exalted.

25 "I shall also set his hand on the **sea** And his right hand on the **rivers.**

26 "He will cry to Me, **"You are my Father, My God, and the ( ) of my salvation.'**

27 "I also shall make him My ( ), **The highest of the kings of the earth.**

28 "My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever, And **My covenant** shall be confirmed to him.

29 **"So I will establish his descendants forever And his throne as the days of heaven.**

30 "If his sons forsake My ( ) And do not walk in My ( ),

32 **Then I will punish their transgression with the rod And their iniquity with stripes.**  
33 "But I will not break off My ( ) from him,  
Nor deal falsely in My faithfulness.  
34 "My ( ) I will not violate, Nor will I alter the utterance of My lips.  
35 "Once I have sworn by My ( ); I will not lie to David.  
36 **"His descendants shall endure forever** And his throne as the sun before Me.  
37 "It shall be established forever like the moon, And the witness in the sky is faithful." Selah.  
38 But You have cast off and rejected, You have been full of wrath against Your ( ).  
39 You have spurned **the covenant** of Your servant; You have profaned his **crown** in the dust.  
40 You have broken down all his walls; You have brought his strongholds to ruin.  
41 **All who pass along the way plunder him;** He has become a reproach to his neighbors.  
42 You have exalted the right hand of his adversaries; You have made all his enemies rejoice.  
43 **You also turn back the edge of his sword And have not made him stand in battle.**  
44 **You have made his splendor to cease And cast his throne to the ground.**  
45 You have shortened the days of his youth; You have covered him with shame. Selah.  
46 How long, O Lord? Will You hide Yourself forever? Will Your wrath burn like fire?  
47 Remember what my ( ) of life is;  
For what ( ) You have created all the sons of men!  
48 What man can live and not see ( )?  
Can he deliver his soul from the power of ( )? Selah.  
49 Where are Your former ( ),  
O Lord, Which You swore to David in Your ( )?  
50 Remember, O Lord, the ( ) of Your servants;  
How I bear in my bosom the ( ) of all the many peoples,  
51 With which Your enemies have ( ), O Lord, With which they  
have ( ) the footsteps of Your ( ).
