Exodus 20:1-21

1 **Then God spoke all these words**, saying,

2 "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of
(_____).

3 "You shall have **no other gods** before (_____).

4 "You shall not make for yourself an (_____), or **any likeness** of what is in
heaven (_____) or on the earth (_____) or in the water
(_____) the earth.

5 You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a (_____)
God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations
of those who (_____) Me,

6 but showing (_____) to thousands, to those
who (_____) Me and (_____) My commandments.

7 "You shall not take the (_____) **of the Lord your God in vain**, for the Lord
will not leave him unpunished who takes His (_____) in vain.

8 "Remember the **sabbath day**, to keep it (_____).

9 Six days you shall (_____) and do all your (_____),

10 but the seventh day is a sabbath of the Lord your God; in it you shall not do any work, you
or your son or your daughter, your male or your female (_____) or your
(_____) or your (_____) who stays with you.

11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them,
and rested on the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day and made it holy.

12 "**Honor your father and your mother**, that your (_____) may be prolonged
in the (_____) which the Lord your God gives you.

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13 "You shall not (_____).

14 "You shall not (_____) (_____).

15 "You shall not (_____).

16 "You shall not bear (_____) witness against your neighbor.

17 "You shall not (_____) your neighbor's house; you shall not (_____) your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

18 All the people perceived the (_____) and the (_____) flashes and the (_____) of the trumpet and the mountain (_____); and when the people saw it, they (_____) and stood at a distance.

19 Then they said to Moses, "**Speak to us yourself and we will listen**; but let not God speak to us, or (_____) will (_____)."

20 Moses said to the people, "Do not be (_____); for God has come in order to (_____) you, and in order that the (_____) of Him may (_____) with you, so that you may not (_____)."

21 So the people stood at a distance, while Moses approached the thick (_____) **where God was.**

22 Then the Lord said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, '**You yourselves have seen that I have spoken to you from heaven.**'"

23 You shall not make other (_____) besides Me; (_____) of silver or (_____) of gold, you shall not make for yourselves.

24 You shall make an altar of earth for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your (_____) offerings and your (_____) offerings, your sheep and your oxen; in every place where I cause My (_____) to be remembered, I will come to you and (_____) you.

25 If you make an altar of stone for Me, you shall not build it of cut stones, for if you wield your tool on it, **you will profane it.**

26 And you shall not go up by (_____) to My altar, so that your (_____) will not be exposed on it.'

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Deuteronomy 23

1 "No one who is emasculated or has his male (_____) cut off shall enter the assembly of the Lord.

2 No one of (_____) birth shall enter the assembly of the Lord; none of his descendants, even to the tenth generation, shall enter the assembly of the Lord.

3 No (_____) or (_____) shall enter the assembly of the Lord; none of their descendants, even to the tenth generation, shall ever enter the assembly of the Lord,

4 because they did not meet you with (_____) and (_____) on the way when you came out of Egypt, and because they hired against you (_____) the **son of Beor** from Pethor of Mesopotamia, **to curse you.**

5 Nevertheless, **the Lord your God was not willing to listen** to (_____), but the Lord your God turned the curse into a (_____) for you because the Lord your God (_____) you.

6 You shall never seek their (_____) or their prosperity all your days.

7 "You shall not detest an (_____), for he is your brother; you shall not detest an (_____), because you were an alien in his land.

8 The sons of the (_____) generation who are born to them may enter the assembly of the Lord.

9 "When you go out as an (_____) against your enemies, you shall keep yourself from every (_____) thing.

10 "If there is among you any man who is unclean because of a (_____) emission, then he must go outside the camp; he may not reenter the camp.

11 But it shall be when evening approaches, he shall bathe himself with (_____), and at sundown he may reenter the camp.

12 "You shall also have a place (_____) the camp and **go out there,**

13 and you shall have a (_____) among your tools, and it shall be when you sit down outside, you shall dig with it and shall turn to cover up your (_____).

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14 Since the Lord your God (_____) in the midst of your camp to deliver you and to defeat your (_____) before you, therefore your camp must be (_____); and **He must not see anything (_____) among you or He will turn away from you.**

15 "You shall not hand over to his master a (_____) who has escaped from his master to you.

16 He shall live with you in your midst, in the place which he shall choose in one of your towns where it pleases him; **you shall not mistreat him.**

17 "None of the daughters of Israel shall be a cult (_____), nor shall any of the sons of Israel be a cult (_____).

18 You shall not bring the hire of a (_____) or the wages of a (_____) into the house of the Lord your God for any votive offering, for both of these are an (_____) to the Lord your God.

19 "You shall not charge (_____) **to your countrymen:** interest on money, food, or anything that may be loaned at interest.

20 **You may charge interest** to a (_____), but to your countrymen you shall not charge interest, so that the Lord your God may bless you in all that you undertake in the (_____) which you are about to enter to possess.

21 "When you make a (_____) to the Lord your God, you shall not delay to pay it, for it would be (_____) in you, and **the Lord your God** will surely require it of you.

22 However, **if you refrain from vowing, it would not be sin in you.**

23 You shall be (_____) to perform what goes out from your (_____), just as you have voluntarily vowed to the Lord your God, what you have promised.

24 "When you enter your **neighbor's vineyard**, then you may (_____) grapes until you are **fully satisfied**, but you shall not put any in your basket.

25 "When you enter your **neighbor's** standing grain, then you may (_____) the **heads with your hand**, but you shall not wield a sickle in your neighbor's standing grain.
